REGULATIONS	<p>Participation is at one's own risk. Clubs are responsible for the health condition of their athletes and for any potential losses or damages (e.g., lost locker keys-20€ per key). All participants must follow the internal rules of Aura Centre: https://www.aurakeskus.ee/majakord/ .</p> <p>If the number of registered swimmers is below 200 or above 400, the organizer reserves the right to modify the competition format. Since the number of lockers is limited, we recommend bringing a large sports bag so personal items can be taken to the poolside if needed.</p>
ACCREDITATION	10 € per swimmer. The accreditation fee includes a personalized lanyard and an organizer's souvenir
ENTRY FEE	12 € per start. Estonian clubs will be invoiced after the competition according to the number of entries by the withdrawal deadline. Foreign clubs shall pay in cash on site

ENTRIES	Entries must be submitted through the Swimrankings system (https://www.swimrankings.net/manager/) and will close on Monday of the competition week at 23:59. Late entries (17 € per start) must be submitted as a Lenex file to voistlused@tuksport.ee no later than Wednesday 19:59
WITHDRAWALS	Withdrawals must be sent to voistlused@tuksport.ee no later than Wednesday evening of the competition week
START LIST	Will be sent to team representatives by Wednesday evening of the competition week
HEAT SHEETS	Will be sent to team representatives by Thursday evening of the competition week
FORCE MAJEURE	If the competition is cancelled or postponed due to circumstances beyond the organizer's control, team representatives will be notified no later than Thursday evening of the competition week
DOPING CONTROL	The competition follows the rules of the World Anti-Doping Code. Testing will be conducted by the Estonian Anti-Doping and Sports Ethics Foundation: https://eadse.ee/eng

COMPETITION RULES	<p>The competition will be held according to World Aquatics (WA) and Estonian Swimming Federation (EUL) rules. In heats, lane assignments are based on entry times, with the fastest swimmers seeded earlier</p> <p>50 m events: heats + finals. The top 16 swimmers from the heats advance to the finals.</p> <p>100 m, 200 m, 400 m, and 800 m events: swum as timed finals</p> <p>400 m: max. 16 swimmers per gender (up to 2M and 2W heats)</p> <p>800 m: max. 8 swimmers per gender (up to 1M and 1W heats)</p>
AWARDS	<p>Top three swimmers in each age category: medals (1st–3rd place)</p> <p>Best overall swimmers (based on total WA points from all events): trophy + sponsor prize.</p> <p>Prizes provided by Mad Wave; Awarded only during official ceremonies</p>
PROTESTS	Protests must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the event. Protest fee: 50 €
